

Visual Art Division

The objective of visual arts participants is to create a piece of artwork that illustrates or illuminates a Scripture verse or passage.

Visual Arts is divided into three areas:

Photo, 2-D Art and 3-D Art.

General Visual Art Guidelines

1. All entries, including photographs, must be original and not a reproduction of another artist's work.
2. All Visual Art Entries **Must** be submitted at registration on Friday night, March 2, 2012. **NO later than 6:30 pm.**
3. All entries must include a 3"X5" card with the artist's name and church name printed on it and firmly attached to the back of the artwork.
4. All entries must also include a **typed** sheet (single sheet) to be displayed with the piece. The following information must be on the typed sheet:
 - a. Title of the piece
 - b. List of media used
 - c. Scripture the piece is based on (written out including reference)
 - d. Brief summary stating how the piece relates to the chosen Scripture verse(s).
5. Judging will be based on the following criteria:
 - a. Communication of chosen Scripture verse(s)
 - b. Quality of presentation (Good artwork is diminished by a sloppy presentation)
 - c. Proficiency in chosen medium
 - d. Perspectives and proportions
 - e. Composition
 - f. Elements of design (use of line, texture, light and dark values, space, emphasis and contrast.)
 - g. Meets objectives and guidelines. Artwork not meeting presentation requirements will not be displayed and will not be adjudicated.
 - h. All artwork will be on display during event weekend. Artwork will be released at after the SuperSaturday afternoon March 3, 2012

Photo Entry Guidelines

1. There are two divisions: black/white and color.
2. All entries must be at least 8X10” and no larger than 11X14”.
3. All entries **MUST** be mounted on foam mounting board.
4. Entry **MUST NOT** be matted or framed.
5. Do not identify photo in any way on front of photo.

2-D Entry Guidelines

This category includes artwork such as drawings, paintings, and chalk or charcoal drawings.

1. All entries must be at least 8X10” and no larger than 11X14”.
2. All entries **MUST** be mounted on foam mounting board.

3-D Entry Guidelines

This category is for free standing art such as sculptures, ceramics, woodwork, carvings, ect.

All entries must be free-standing and ready for table top display.
